- iii. Select Payment Category: "New Students – First Semester Fee". (Other payment categories will also be made available in due course of time.)
- iv. Enter the **Lab Code of CSIR where you are selected: 22** & your **AcSIR Application No.** as above in table and click the button "SUBMIT".
- v. All corresponding details pertaining to above entered AcSIR Application number will be displayed by the system. Please check these details. (Do not proceed further if any inconsistent/ incomplete/ incorrect information is found and report the problem/ difficulty by communication to sbicollect@acsir.res.in as defined in the Note at the end.)
- vi. Enter Student's E-mail ID and Mobile No.
- vii. Enter suitable Remarks, if any.
- viii. Enter Name, Date of Birth, Mobile Number of the person (Student himself/ herself or someone else who is making this payment for the AcSIR Student) and the text as shown in the CAPTCHA image.
 - a. Above details can be used to reprint the e-receipt/ remittance form OR viewing the payment history. It can be accessed from drop-down options available under State Bank Collect (left top corner).
 - b. Also, above details are of person making the payment, not necessarily the student. Click 'SUBMIT'; verify details on the next page and then click "CONFIRM".
- ix. On the next page, proceed with the Payment through anyone of the preferable Modes of Payment as under:

 - (b) Card Payments: Credit Cards
 - (c) Other Payments Modes: SBI Branch (i.e. generate a pre-printed challan and pay at any SBI Branch), NEFT/RTGS &UPI
